### **Eligibility**

The show is open to artists 18 and older who are residents of Brunswick County or who are members of the Associated Artists of Southport, Oak Island Art Guild, Waterway Art Association, Coastal Carolina Camera Club or the Brunswick Arts Council.

### **Conditions**

Entries must be original works, not previously shown at the BAC Annual Fall Exhibition. Ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, or a combination of the listed media created in the last four years (2013 - 2017) will be considered. 2D art works must be suitably framed and securely wired ready to hang. 2D entries 30" or larger must be framed under plexiglas. All entries must not exceed 40" in any direction. 3D work must not exceed 50 pounds. No entry that requires the artist to be present for moving or assembly will be accepted.

### **Entry Fee**

A maximum of two art works are allowed per Artist. Submit a non-refundable entry fee of \$35, BAC members, \$40 non members.

Artists will receive 100% of sales price. Works may be listed as *Not For Sale*.

## JUDGES

### Judging Criteria

Each entry will be judged as a unique art work relating to the elements of art, success of craftsmanship, presentation, and theme.

**Judge Alex Powers** was born in 1940 and raised in Coeburn, Virginia. He has a B.A. in mathematics from Emory & Henry College, Emory, VA. He studied art with teachers he liked in FL, MA, CT, and NY. Alex has lived in Myrtle Beach, SC and has been a painter and self-employed art teacher since 1970. Among his many national juried exhibition awards is the Gold Medal at the 1997 American Watercolor Society Annual Exhibition. His 2011 museum retrospective was accompanied by a 41 page catalog, which is available from Alex. He is the author of *Painting People in Watercolor, A Design Approach*, which has been republished by Echo Point Books & Media and is available from Alex. He has posted 250 to 300 paintings and drawings on Facebook with text for most of them. Facebook comments say that, with the text, it is like a free art class.
