

GENERAL INFORMATION

Eligibility

Any artist 18 years or older may enter two 2-D works and/or two 3-D works of pottery or sculpture. Work must be original, entirely the work of a single artist, executed within the last 3 years, and not exhibited in any previous AAS Spring Show. No computer-generated or digitally altered imagery, photography, air brush, furniture, fiber art, or tole painted pieces will be accepted. AAS reserves the right to refuse any work that is not properly presented, requires special installation, or is deemed inappropriate by the AAS Media Committee.

All work must be for sale. AAS will retain a commission of 25% for members and 35% for nonmembers on all sales. The artist is committed to the sale price on the entry form. Entries must remain for the duration of the show (unless sold).

Artwork Specifications

- All 2-D artwork must be framed, wired, and ready to hang.
- No saw-tooth hangers are permitted.
- Gallery wrapped canvas must be at least 1.25" deep and all edges must be painted.
- Rigid Plexiglas is required for pieces over 30" in any direction.
- No image may be smaller than 9" by 12".
- Maximum framed size cannot exceed 50".
- No artwork may exceed 50 lbs.
- Work needing special installation will not be accepted.
