Fashion Show Schedule

The Arts & Parts Runway Show stage will have a “fashion show” style feel in daylight on an outdoor stage. It will be a well-lit, high stage that goes out into the crowd. Contestants are encouraged to strut their recycled stuff on stage.

The program will be as follows for Saturday:

- Contestants arrive at 3:00-3:30 pm to separate tent beside large tent w/stage & check in.
- 4:00 pm Fashion Show order:
 - 8 and under contestants.
 - 9-11 year-old contestants.
 - 12-15 year-old contestants.
 - 16-19 year-old contestants.
 - Adult contestants.
- All contestants on stage for a promenade (maintaining social distancing).
- All contestants off stage waiting for winners to be announced.
- Youth and Adult Juried Art Winners Announced
- Fashion Show Winners announced. Winners come on stage as announced.

COVID -19 Event Operations

What we are doing:

- Please mind the 6 feet apart from other contestants to allow social distancing.
- Signage explaining social distance, 3 W's and market procedures will be posted around the festival.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be set up in the tent for participants to use.
- Wait in line 6ft. spaces apart for fashion show.

What we are asking participants to do:

- Contestants, Parents and friends are encouraged to wear face coverings/masks, if available.
- Contestants who are sick are asked to stay at home.
- Participants who do not follow these procedures will be asked to leave event.
